Concord, NH - NHGOP Chairman Wayne MacDonald released the following statement regarding the NHGOP Executive Board endorsing Question 1 on the November Ballot:

"The Executive Committee of the New Hampshire Republican State Committee met and discussed the issue of Constitutional Amendment Question 1, and whether to support it as a Party. By unanimous vote, it was decided that the New Hampshire Republican State Committee will publicly support passage of the Amendment. We endorse, and we will support and advocate for, passage of Question 1 on November 6, 2018."

Question 1 would add the following to the New Hampshire Constitution:

The public also has a right to an orderly, lawful, and accountable government. Therefore, any individual taxpayer eligible to vote in the State shall have standing to petition the Superior Court to declare whether the State or political subdivision in which the taxpayer resides has spent, or has approved spending, public funds in violation of a law, ordinance, or constitutional provision. In such a case, the taxpayer shall not have to demonstrate that his or her personal rights were impaired or prejudiced beyond his or her status as a taxpayer.

The NHGOP asks all New Hampshire voters, regardless of party, vote to pass this bipartisan Constitutional Amendment.
